	Millennial Theories				
1	Premillennialists – Jesus will return before the millennium				

- 2. Postmillennialists Jesus will return after the millennium.
- 3. Amillennialists The millennium is not a literal period but is symbolic of a great time of gospel expansion.

## **Rapture/Tribulation Theories**

- 1. "Pre-tribbers" believe that the rapture occurs before the tribulation, followed by the glorious appearing.
- 2. "Mid-tribbers" put the rapture midway in the tribulation.
- 3. "Post-tribbers" believe there is one return (the rapture and glorious appearing are the same) after the tribulation.

Theories are combined: A pre-tribulationist pre-millenialist is common. There is more to it as well—there are differing theories about the relationship of Old Testament Israel and the church
