And if you change your outlook—your attitudes—you can and will change your actions and your character and others will notice.

The Bible is full of examples. Here are three in the New Testament:

- John—a "Son of Thunder"—was known for his temper. After Jesus changed him, He was known as the "Apostle of Love" an extreme change.
- Paul was known for His anger and hatred for Christians and Gentiles. Later, after Jesus changed Him, he became the lead Christian of his generation (and maybe of all time) and wrote the best description of love (I Corinthians 13) ever written.
- Peter was impetuous, temperamental, and hard-headed. Yet as Jesus changed him over time, he was able to lead the church calmly through some very tough times in Acts 1-15.
